



IMMUNIZATION AND HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Granada Islamic School requires that students entering grades Pre-K to 8 complete all the immunizations required (*per requirements of the California Department of Health CDPH*) Please refer to the *Guide to Immunizations Required for School Entry Grades K-12* at: <http://eziz.org/assets/docs/IMM-231.pdf>

ALL GRADES

1. Immunization as per requirements
2. Birth Certificate
3. All students entering grades 1-8 must complete the Transcript Request Form

Pre-K and Staff Day Care

1. Immunizations as per the California Immunization Requirements for Child Care IMM 230 (1/08)
2. Birth Certificate

KINDERGARTEN

1. TB test (PPD Mantoux) (The skin test must have been completed within 18 months prior to entering Kindergarten)
2. Immunization as per requirements for K-12
3. 3 doses of Hepatitis B
4. 2 doses of MMR
5. One dose of varicella or varicella (chicken pox) disease history documented by physician
6. A physical exam done within 6 months before entering Kindergarten. "Report of Health Examination for School Entry" should be completed by your child's doctor. (form enclosed)
7. Birth Certificate

All students entering Kindergarten must bring proof of having had the required vaccination before starting school. This includes current students and new students.

FIRST GRADE

1. TB test (PPD Matoux) (if Kindergarten was skipped)
2. 3 doses of Hepatitis B (if Kindergarten was skipped)
3. 2 doses of MMR (if Kindergarten was skipped)
4. Immunization as per requirements for K-12
5. A physical exam done within 18 months before entering 1st grade. "Report of Health Examination for School Entry" should be completed by your child's doctor. (form enclosed)
6. Birth Certificate

GRADE 7

1. 3 doses of Hepatitis B
2. 2 doses of MMR
8. 1 dose varicella or varicella (chicken pox) disease history documented by physician
3. Tdap

GRADES 7-12

1. Whooping Cough booster shot for adolescents (Tdap)
All students entering or advancing into 7th – 12th grades must show proof of having had the Tdap booster shot before starting school. This includes current students, new students and transfer students in both public and private schools.

OUT OF SANTA CLARA COUNTY / OUT-OF-STATE ENTRANTS

1. TB skin (PPD Matoux) test is required for all students transferring into Grades K-12, from outside Santa Clara County. This skin test must have been completed 18 months prior to entry into Kindergarten and 6 months prior to transfer into grades 1 – 12.
2. Varicella is required for students entering Grades 1 - 12 from outside the State of California.
