



Registration Process 2019-20 (Continuing Students)

Important dates regarding Registration Process 2019-20

1. Early Registration Window (January 28 - February 7, 2019)
2. Regular Registration Window (February 8 – February 14, 2019)
After February 14, continuing students lose all admission priority and will be required to fill out a Waiting List Application and wait for any available openings.

Forms required at Registration:

1. Registration Form(s)
2. Financial Agreement (fm 420)
3. GIS Direct Payment Authorization (fm 424)
4. GIS Emergency Information 2019-20
5. Copy of child's Immunization Record

Fees due at Registration:

1. Early Registration Fee (January 28 - February 7, 2019) : \$75 per student
2. Regular Registration Fee (February 8- February 14, 2019) : \$175 per student
3. Activity Fee : \$100 per K-8 student & \$500 per 9-12 student
4. Capital Campaign Fee : \$150 per student

Immunization Requirements:

1. Kindergarten: Submit Report of Health Exam completed by your child's doctor and a record of all required immunizations including TB testing (per requirements of the California Department of Health CDPH). For more information, please refer to: *Guide to the immunizations required for School Entry, Grades K-12, IMM 231(01/08)*
2. Grade 7: Submit written proof of having taken T-dap booster shot. California Immunization Law now requires students entering/advancing to grades 7-12 in both public and private schools to submit proof of having taken an adolescent whooping cough booster shot called T-dap before starting school. By law, students who do not have proof of receiving a T-dap booster shot will not be able to start school until proof is provided to the school.
